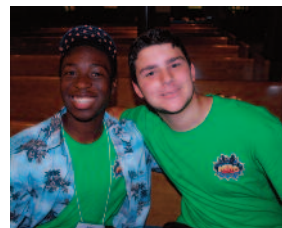

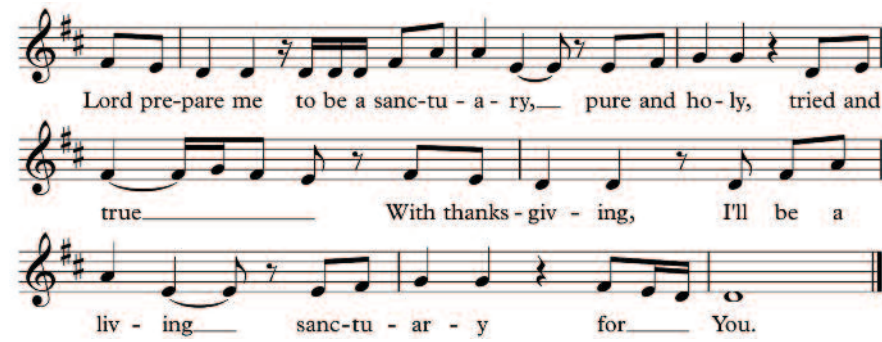

*PRAYER OF CONFESSION

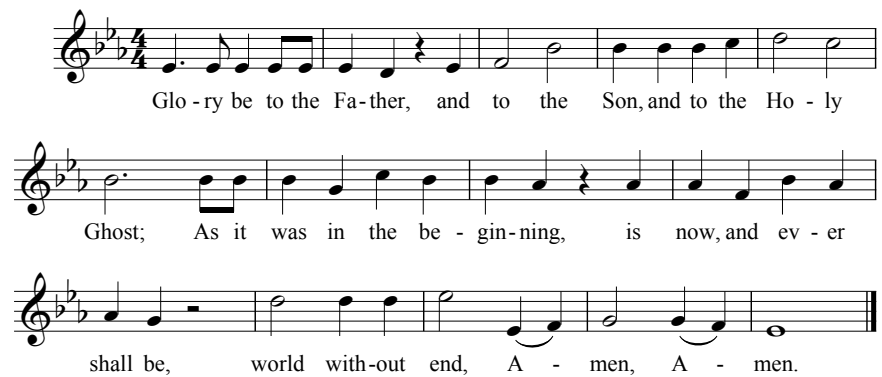
