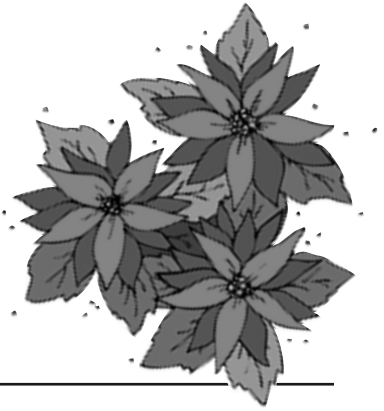
Calling all Trivia Buffs AND Non-Trivia Buffs! – Saturday, January 21, 6:00 PM
