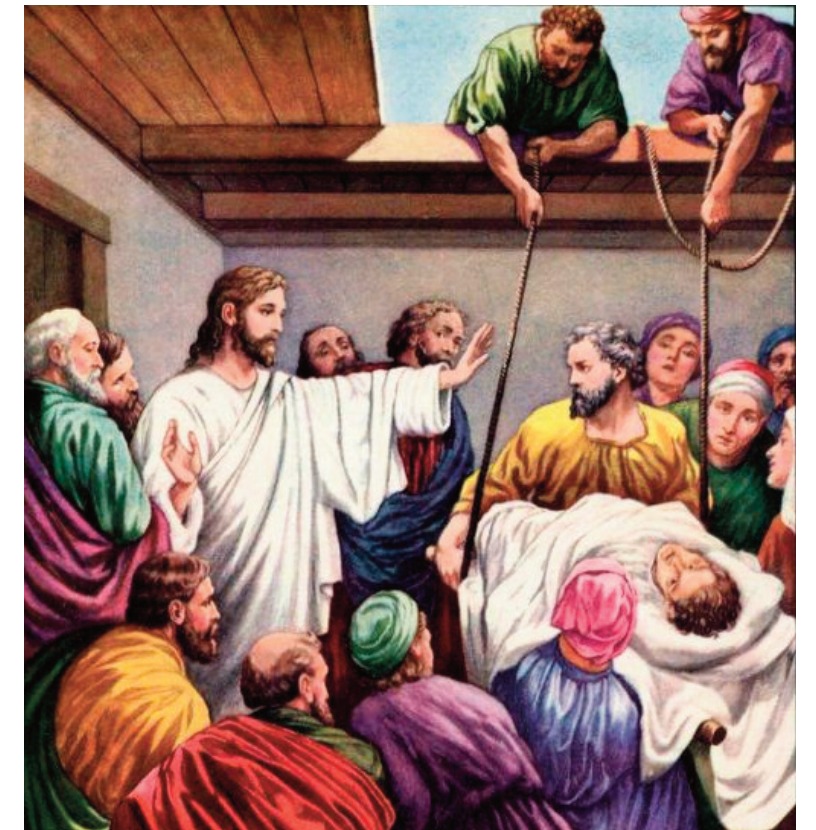
**Hospital visits** by the Pastor to members and friends of the church, are made only with a patient's permission.
